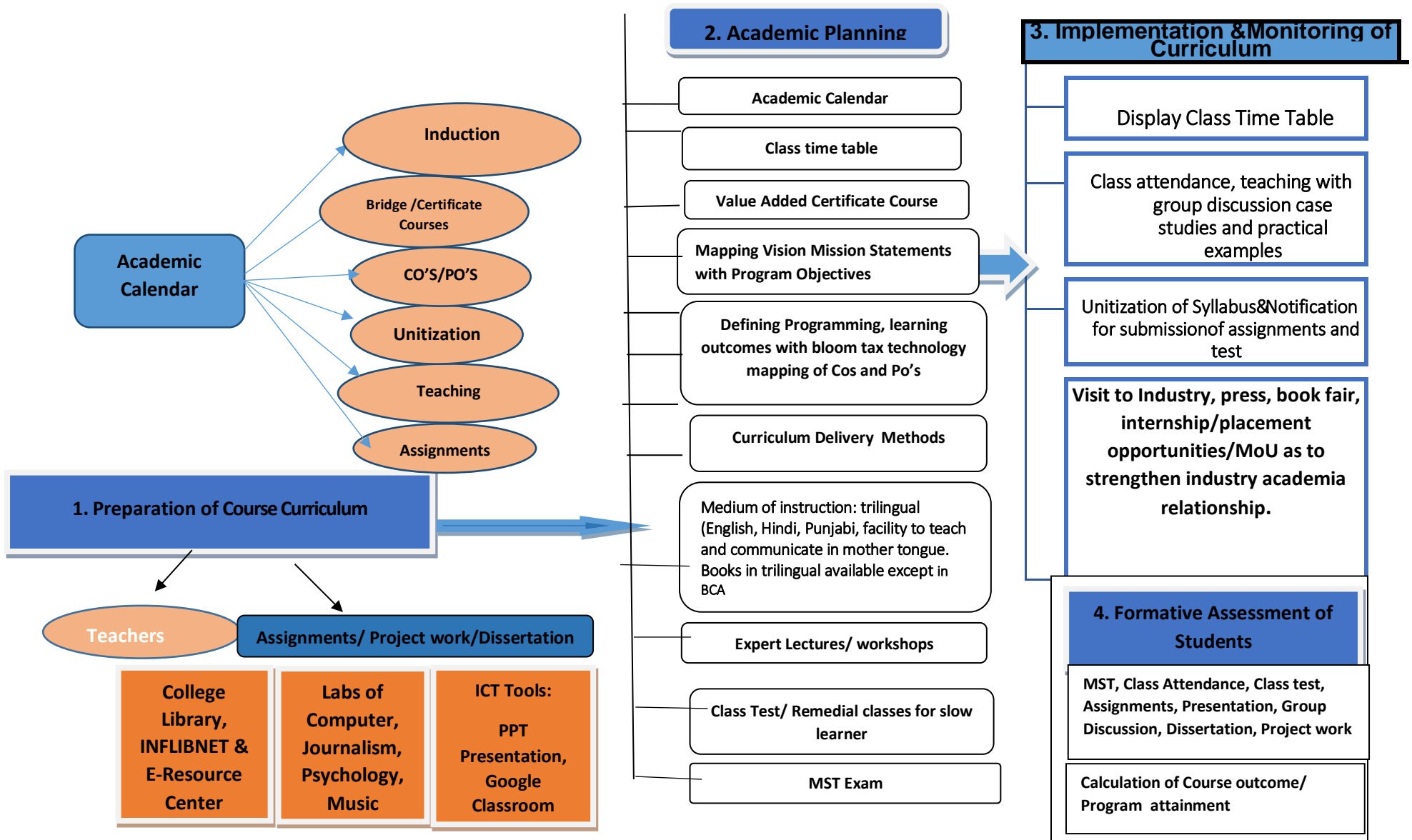
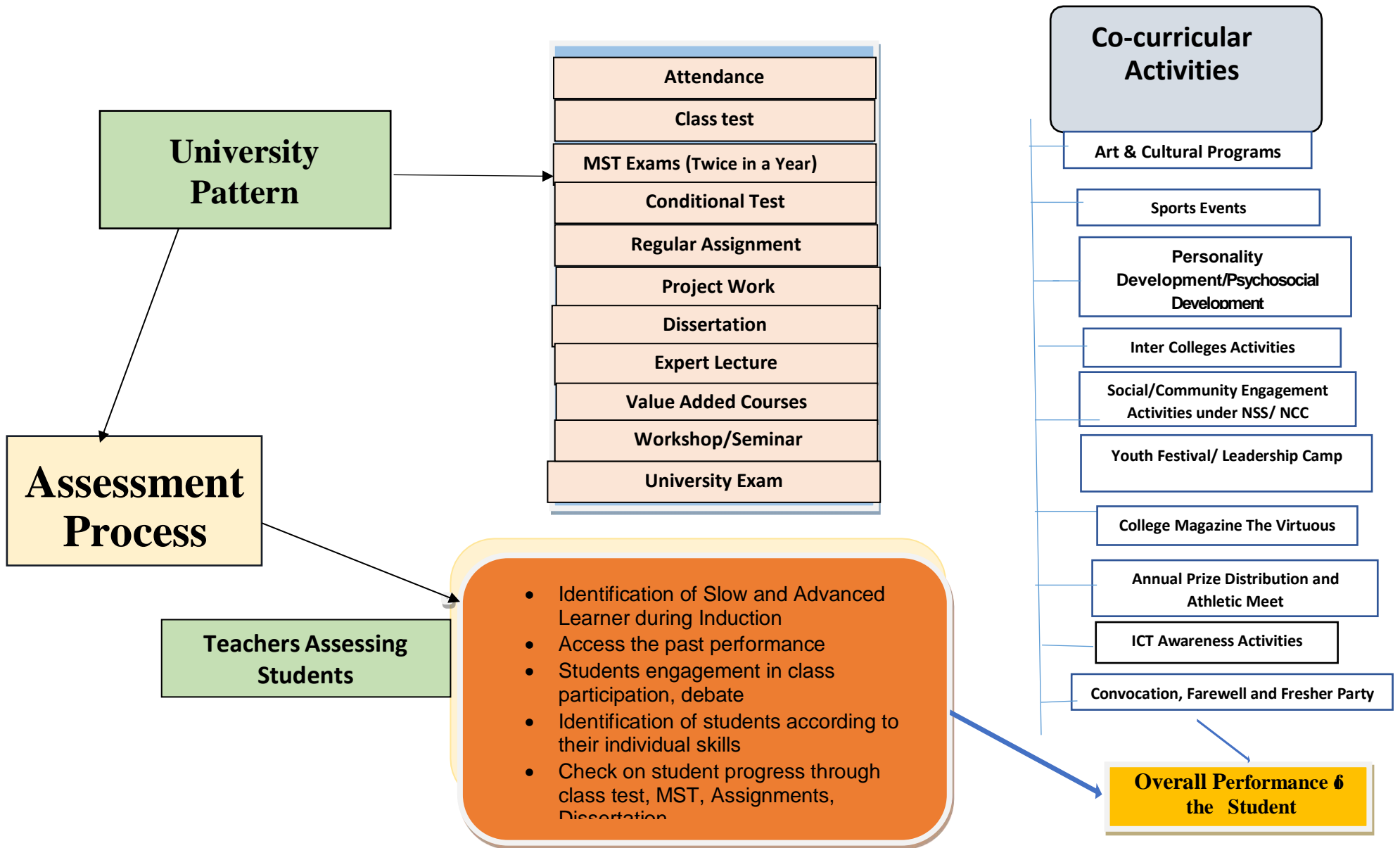

Sr. No.	Methods	Details
1.	Conventional Lecture method: (e.g. Chalk & Talk)	
2	ICT Enabled: (e.g. The teacher incorporates technology, such as computers, interactive whiteboards and multimedia resources, to enhance the learning experience.)	
3	Lecture-Demonstration: (e.g. lecture followed by Demonstration)	
4	Presentations: (e.g. The teacher delivers information or content using visual aids, such as slideshows/ posters/ banners/ DTH/Charts/ graphs/ hangouts/video/ map/ photographs)	
5	Simulation/Role Play: (e.g. Students engage in simulated real-life situations or take on specific roles to experience and learn through practical application.)
