

#### A Brief Summary of the Seminar on The Theme:

#### Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC on 3rd March, 2020 (Tuesday)

The whole scenario of higher education is considerably changing and evolving globally with ever widening sphere of knowledge and emergent educational reforms catering the needs of twenty-first century learners. National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) which is an autonomous body funded by University Grants Commission (UGC) of Government of India has got down to revise the assessment and accreditation (A&A) methodology. The prime focus of this seminar was on "Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC" and varied parameters of revised accreditation framework, data validation and verification process and the whole process of assessment and accreditation in detail. Higher Education Institutes (HEIs) have to go for accreditation process to ensure that youth empowered with quality education and could lead nation on the path of growth and development. Experts from NAAC and other accredited institutions having vast experience in assessment and accreditation delivered lectures and shared their experiences in execution of accreditation process.

This intellectual venture set up a platform for the institutes across the nation to share the best practices of their respective institutes for holistic academic excellence.

Through this seminar, non-accredited institutions also came up with valuable inputs about quality enhancement and sustenance.

The seminar had opened the door on lively and stimulating ideas on the issue of Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC by the chief guest and keynote speaker Dr. Manpreet Singh Manna, Director (Administration) and SWAYAM Project Cell In-charge in his keynote address. He ruminated over all criterions of NAAC highlighting the things to be considered while filling the accreditation form from the perspective of NAAC. He recommended the institutions to uplift the standards of quality education and this goal can be accomplished by educating faculty also with the process and benefits of Accreditation Process and adapting quality culture in promoting higher education. This can be accomplished by optimal usage of OBE tools such as open education resource, flip learning and blended learning. Improvement in Process can be matured by valuable inputs from a regular feedback from all the stakeholders (Students, Parents, Faculty, industry & Government).

To conclude, he remarked that no education will be complete without inculcation of values among the learners. Hence, there is a dire need to reform teaching pedagogy to enable learners to use the knowledge gained through their respective courses to tackle problems they are going to face in day-to-day life.

#### DR. DINESH KUMAR

Dr. Dinesh Kumar, IQAC Member, Professor, Dept. of Geophysics, Kurukshetra University shared his views on Revised Assessment and Accreditation Framework by NAAC and also on Program Outcomes(POs), Program Specific Outcomes(PSOs), Course Outcomes(COs) and their Attainment. He explained in detail about the weight age of all the criterions in the revised framework. He informed that all the institutions intending to apply for Assessment and Accreditation by NAAC need to mandatorily upload the information on All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) portal. AISHE code (reference number) is one of the requirements for Registration and submission of Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQAR) to NAAC. He delivered a detail discussion on the new process of uploading of AQAR, mandatory checks before preparation and uploading of IIQA. He also discussed on weightage of various criteria for qualitative and quantitative aspect. In his lecture he suggested a number of innovative and quality practices to improve standards of higher education that needs to be practiced by all HEI's.

#### **Assessment Process**

- Submission of Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA)
- Self Study Report: Quantitative (70%) and Qualitative (30%)
- Student Satisfaction Survey
- Peer Team Report
- SSR (Only online) with the required documents has to be uploaded in the portal of NAAC website within 45 days of acceptance of IIQA.

#### **Pre-Qualifier**

- Step 1: Submit Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) online.
- Step 2: After the acceptance of IIQA, the SSR has to be uploaded as per the format in portal of NAAC.

(The SSR comprises both Qualitative (30%) and Quantitative (70%) metrics.)

Step 3: The quantitative matrices of SSR will be sent for Data Validation and Verification (DVV) Process by NAAC. A DVV Deviation report will be generated. The accreditation and assessment process will proceed further based on the DVV report.

- Institutions whose metrics are found to be deviated will be liable for the penalty or legal action. Their first installment of accreditation fees will also be forfeited.
- Institutions that clears the DVV process will proceed for Peer Team Visit with the condition of a pre- qualifier that the institution should score at least 25% in Quantitative Metrics.
- If an institution does not clear the Pre-qualifier stage, then they will have to apply afresh by submitting the IIQA and its fees. Such HEIs are eligible to apply again after six months

#### DR. K. G SRINIVASA

While speaking on the DVV Process, Dr K. G Srinivasa, Professor at NITTTR, Chandigarh elaborated that in 2017 Revised Accreditation council framework of HEIs in three stages process. It is first uploading of

- institutional information for quality assessment IIQA and Self Study Report.
- Verification and Validation of documents and data and outcome report.
- Acceptance and conferment of accreditation status that institution needs two sets of documents.
- Qualitative Matrices
- Quantitative Matrices

Every claim made by institution needs to be verified and validated, validation of claims depends upon verification of corresponding documentary evidence. The kind of the data to be uploaded for each quantitative matric is indicated in tabular form and documents required are listed. Documents such as

- Minutes of meeting
- Decision
- Statement of accounts
- Awards letters
- Letter of appointment

- Minutes and IQAC regarding Quality initiative taken in the institution.
- Best Practices Authentic proof
- Program and Course outcomes.
- Academics and Research Achievements/Publications
   where so ever these are in bulk hyperlink for each of the document must be attached to be verified during DVV process.

He explained that large number of institution came down on CGPA and Grade und the 2017 framework largely due to failure of data validation and verification process. Traditional institutes are generally deficient in Administration, documentation and data management. Another important reason of failure is non availability of e-content /documents /proofs on website of the issuing authorises.

He further explored the importance of management information system in every institution. All activities will have to be make normal and corresponding documents created.

#### DR. AMIT DEOGAR

Speaking on the needs of Open source system in the present time, Dr. Amit Deogar stated about the usage and features of open source systems. He revealed that a number of IT giants have opted use of open source system in order to reduce the licensing needs and cost. Stressing on need of use of Open Source System, Dr. Deogar demonstrated a number of system software options available as open source operating systems. He added that open source system can be used in Research and Innovation as the code for the system is readily available for modification and reuse. Speaking on NAAC Revised Accreditation framework and need of data storage that is to be provided as online access in the form of links to support various criteria, he suggested use of cloud services like amazon cloud to cater the need of hour. Dr. Deogar also answered the queries of participants as how and where to find the open source system and how to find an equivalent software as per need of user. He listed a number of open source website and software like Libra office, Foss and a number of website from where this software can be readily downloaded and used. He also added MHRD run projects like Swayam, NDL (National Digital Library), NPTEL and other premier institute course run and freely available as moocs on MHRD, YouTube, NPTEL and other websites. Giving stress to promote open software system, he stressed on need to recognized open system as a part of Curriculum of various technical and non-technical courses. He added that all universities and education bodies must keep a healthy view while

designing syllabus towards recognition of need of open software usage. In concluding remarks, he shared a number of online resources with participant for downloading and using the open source software's.

#### PANEL DISCUSSION

During the Open House Panel Discussion, Dr Dinesh Kumar; Dr. Manpreet Singh Manna; Dr. Mohinder Kaur Grewal, Former Principal, Govt. College for Girls Ludhiana; Dr Sarita Bahl, Principal, D.D Jain Memorial College, Ludhiana; Dr Neena Seth Pajni, Principal GPC & NAAC Assessor had been the panellists along with the principals of accredited colleges.

It was a very interactive activity to resolve the queries regarding the perplexity associated with "Innovative and Best Practices" in the college. The panel held the view that Best Practice is the activity which in continuum over a period of years. The second query was how to calculate placement ration of the institution. The panel cleared it up that in order to calculate the placement of student ratio is one has to assess total students inside or outside the campus to total students admitted in the college. The discussion concluded with Dr. Sarita Bahl's remarks on team-spirit among the faculty, non-teaching department which can help to get higher score in institution's accreditation. The discussion concluded with the to upload any file for SSR it must contain authentic information of the students with their email id, class, roll number, program outcome and news clips should be kept as record to validate such activity.
