Gobindgarh Public College, Alour alongwith Gobindgarh Public School, Punjab Institute of Management and Technology and Gobindgarh College of Education is an Institution of Gobindgarh Educational and Social Welfare Trust which is providing excellent opportunities for comprehensive and quality education to the people of the steel town and its surrounding areas. The Trust had always been keen to have association with Panjab University, Chandigarh. Gobindgarh Public College, Alour is the result of the steely resolve shown by the Trust to take steel Town higher and higher on the educational map of the State of Punjab. Formal inauguration of the building of the College was done by Prof. K.N. Pathak, Vice- Chancellor, Panjab University, Chandigarh on September 29, 2003 on the auspicious occasion of the Silver Jubilee of the Trust. The College is located in a magnificent building having an ultra modern infrastructure and excellent academic environment. In its short span of life the college has achieved tremendous success may be in the academic, cultural or sports activities.

In the academic sphere, our students have shown very good results. This College has two streams- Arts and Commerce. Performance of our students in both the streams is remarkable. **30** students bagged First Divisions in B.Com-III, **14** students bagged First Divisions in B.Com-II, **24** students bagged First Divisions in B.Com-I, **15** students bagged First Divisions in B.A-III, **11** students bagged First Divisions in B.A-II and **11** students bagged First Divisions in B.A-I in the Panjab University Annual Examinations, 2006. Narinder Pal Shahi of B.Com-III stood first in the College in Panjab University Annual Examinations-2006 by securing 71.72% marks, Sahil Singla of B.Com-II stood first securing 73.82% marks Manisha of B.Com-I stood first by securing 76% marks, Meenu Khullar of B.A-III stood first by securing 67.62%, Amit Kumar Gupta of B.A.-II stood first by securing 68.56% marks and Sandeep Kaur of B.A-I stood first by securing 68.25% . In order to improve the tally of First Divisions, system of

conducting monthly class tests has been introduced and special classes for week and brilliant students are being organized. All these efforts are bound to bring good fruit in Annual University Examinations, 2007. Extension Lectures are organized in the College to provide wider information on specific issues.
