Gobindgarh Public College, Alour is the result of the steely resolve shown by the Trust to take steel Town higher and higher on the educational map of the State of Punjab. Formal inauguration of the building of the College was done by Prof. K.N. Pathak, Vice- Chancellor, Panjab University, Chandigarh on September 29, 2003 on the auspicious occasion of the Silver Jubilee of the Trust. The College is located in a magnificent building having an ultra modern infrastructure and excellent academic environment. In its short span of life the college has achieved tremendous success may be in the academic, cultural or sports activities.

In the academic sphere, our students have shown very good results. This College has four streams- Arts, Commerce, Business Administration & Computer Application. Performance of our students in all the streams is remarkable. **28** students bagged First Divisions in B.Com-III, **27** students bagged First Divisions in B.Com-II, **16** students bagged First Divisions in B.Com-I, **15** students bagged First Divisions in B.A-III, **11** students bagged First Divisions in B.A-II, **11** students bagged First Divisions in B.A-I, **11** students bagged First Divisions in B.C.A-I and **14** students bagged First Divisions in B.B.A-I in the Panjab University Annual Examinations, 2008. Jagmohan Goyal of B.Com-III stood first in the College in Panjab University Annual Examinations-2008 by securing 75.83% marks, Rohini Gupta of B.Com-II stood first by securing 73.39% marks, Kiranpreet Kaur of B.Com-I stood first by securing 76.54% marks, Sandeep Kaur of B.A-III stood first by securing 70.67%, Neha Jindal of B.A.-II stood first by securing 71% marks, Rani Kumari of B.A-I stood first by securing 71.5%, Amandeep Singh of B.C.A-I stood first by securing 73% and Ritika Sharma of

B.B.A-I stood first by securing 73.06%. In order to improve the tally of First Divisions, system of conducting monthly class tests has been introduced and special classes for weak and brilliant students are being organized. Assessment of the students is a regular features of the College. All these efforts are bound to bring good fruit in Annual University Examinations, 2009. Extension Lectures are organized in the College to provide wider information on specific issues.

Hindi Divas was celebrated on 14th September, 2008. On this occasion a poetry recitation competition, declamation contest and a small skit was performed by the students.
