Action Taken Report



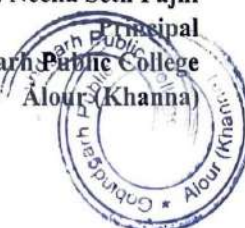
