Post Graduate Courses and Eligibility <u>Master of Arts in Punjabi</u> (Semester System)

The duration of the course of instruction for the Master of Arts examination shall be two years and the examination shall be held in four semesters. First and third semester shall be from July to December and Second and fourth semester shall be from January to May respectively, or as decided by the Vice-Chancellor, Panjab University, Chandigarh. The examination shall be conducted at the end of each semester only in those courses which have been offered in that semester.

Eligibility condition for M.A. (Punjabi) (Semester-I)

- B.A with Honours in English/ Punjabi
- Graduation in any stream with at least 50 % marks in aggregate.
- PGDCA, Diploma in Physical Education, Post Graduate Diploma in Library Science or any diploma after having passed B.A. or B.Sc.
- B.A (Pass) in full subjects obtaining at least 45% marks in English/ Punjabi as an Elective subject.
- Master's degree in a subject other than English/Punjabi.
- B.Sc. Honours School.
- Bachelor in Education (B.Ed)
- B.B.A./ B.Com./B.C.A./B.E. (having studied English as a subject for one full year/two semesters)

Eligibility conditions for admission in M.A. (Punjabi) (Semester III)

The vacant seats in each category may be filled by the respective boards of control on merit if any candidate so admitted shall have secured marks in semester I & II not less than the marks of the last candidate in the merit list of students promoted by the department from M.A. Semester -II to Semester-III and the outside candidate (other than the regular student of respective Department) having reappeared/Compartment will not be considered for admission to M.A. Semester III.
