Objectives:

3. To encourage and facilitate the publication of the research works in reputed academic International / National journals and also to facilitate the presentation of the research work through academic events such as workshops/seminars/conferences.
4. To identify and inform faculty about the appropriate research opportunities announced by different academic, research, industry or government organizations.
5. To promote interdisciplinary research involving more than one knowledge domains.
6. To identify and establish linkages including MOUs for long term relationships with national and international academic organizations for widening the scope of research opportunities available to the teachers of the college.

Research Support to faculty

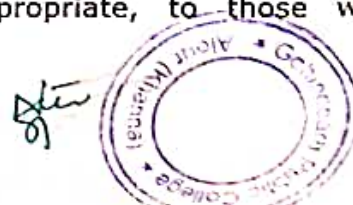
To provide research support to faculty, the College Principal has decided that:

- Once in a session, the faculty can get reimbursement of registration fees paid by them to attend any Conference/Seminar outside.
- The college will reimburse partial registration fees for all faculty members to attend all Conferences/ Seminars/ Workshops conducted by college itself.

Code of Conduct for Research

Faculty of GPC is required to follow the below mentioned code of conduct of research:

- Do not falsify, fabricate, plagiarise, mislead, or misrepresent (either in writing, through electronic/online means or by any other means)
- Do not deviate from accepted practices in the specific research discipline or pertaining to specific communities
- Obtain all relevant licenses, permits, permissions, and protocols, where necessary.
- Appropriately reference and cite the work of others
- Give credit, including authorship where appropriate, to those who have contributed to the research.



- Retain clear, accurate, secure and complete records of all research including research data and primary materials

Code of Ethics for Plagiarism Check

1. It is the objective of the college to create awareness among the faculty regarding the responsible conduct of research and prevention of misconduct including plagiarism.
2. The college aims to develop systems to detect plagiarism and set up mechanisms to prevent plagiarism.
3. The college uses well known software like turnitin and other online tools for plagiarism check.
4. The College shall take serious note of any lapses on the part of faculty in this regard.
